



2017-2018 KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST Ledgemont Elementary

Each Kindergarten student will need to bring the following supplies to orientation or on the first day of school. Personal storage space in the classroom is limited. Sizes are specified to insure that your child will be able to successfully organize his or her supplies.

- 1 Pack Crayola markers
- 10 Glue sticks (Elmer's only)
- 1 bottle liquid glue
- 2 small pack of crayons (24 count)
- 1 kit of watercolor paints
- 1 plain colored pocket folder with 3 prongs inside for paper insert (no binders please)
- 1 pair of round tipped children's scissors (no caps on scissors)
- 1 box of zip loc freezer bags Gallon size (boys) Quart size (girls)
- 2 box of Kleenex
- 1 large back pack labeled with child's name
- 10 dry Erase markers (Expo only)
- 1 container sanitizing wipes
- 1 pair of gym shoes to be left at school (non-tie preferred)
- 1 **Change of clothing to be kept at school for emergencies** (Shirt, pants, underwear, socks for year round weather. Please put extra clothing in a gallon sized Ziploc bag *labeled* with your child's name.)

**Crayons, glue and scissors will be shared by all students throughout the year.
(Please do not label these items.)

**No art boxes please.

**During the winter months students are expected to bring boots, snow pants, a coat, hat, and gloves everyday regardless of current weather conditions.

While preparing your child for Kindergarten, here are lists of suggestions which will make his/her adjustment to school much easier for them.

1. **All** outer items of clothing **must be labeled** with the child's name, including snow pants and boots.
2. Boots, gloves, mittens, hats, coats, shoes, etc., should all be easily put on and fastened, as the children will be expected to dress themselves.
3. Money sent to school for any reason, (lunch, books, etc.) must be in an envelope or some safe container such as change purse etc. and **must be labeled** as to intended use of money and with **child's first and last name**. (Ziploc bags work best and can be used over and over again.)
4. **Velcro shoes only, unless your child can tie shoes independently without assistance.**
